For the second year running, Unity Foundation will be at the ING Night Marathon as part of UNITY RUN 42 – a discipline specially designed for secondary schools in partnership with the organizer of the Grand Duchy’s biggest sporting event. **This initiative, which is part of our mission to build the capacity of young people, offers a number of benefits:** a return to physical exercise, identification with the values of one’s school and the strengthening of team spirit, all combined with a commitment to solidarity for a good cause.
